



# LIPSA 2022

## USPSA Shotgun Match



**8 stages**

**95 rounds birdshot**

### Divisions:

- **Stock Pump:** max 5 rds. (4+1) loaded at start. Max 5 rounds in gun during course of fire
- **Limited Pump:** max 9 rds. (8 +1) to start. Max 11 rounds in gun during COF.
- **Stock Auto:** max 5 rds. (4+1) loaded at start. Max 5 rounds in gun during COF.
- **Limited Auto:** Max 9 rds. (8+1) loaded at start. Max 11 rds. in gun during COF.
- **Open:** Max 11 rds. (10+1) loaded at start. Max 11 rds. in gun during COF. Optics and speed loaders permitted.

### Match Rules:

- No ammunition or speed loading devices in shooters hand at start signal (*rule 8.2.4*)
- Shooters found exceeding the round count limitations of their declared divisions after the start signal up to and including the unload and show clear command will be moved to Open.
- A functioning shotgun plate **MUST** fall to score. IT is not range equipment failure if a functioning shotgun plate is hit insufficiently enough to fall (*rule 4.3.5*)

### Penalties:

**Miss:** -5 pts.

**FTE:** -5 pts

**Procedural:** -5 pts



# SAFETY FIRST !!



Shotguns **MUST** have a chamber flag that is easily visible when transporting from vehicles or stage to stage (*rule 5.2.2.1.2*).

Unbagged shotguns being carried **MUST** be carried shouldered or slung from shoulder “vertically upwards” (*rule 5.2.2.1.3*).

Firearms that are being transported on a cart, vehicle, or other such conveyance **MUST** be situated on the conveyance in either a muzzle up or muzzle down orientation if not bagged. Under such conditions long guns **MUST** have a chamber safety flag inserted. The muzzle of any such firearm, if oriented down, **MUST** point to a spot within 3 feet of the conveyance. If pointed up, it **MUST** be oriented such that a person walking around the conveyance will not be covered by the muzzle if they are more than 3 feet away from the conveyance (*rule 5.2.4*).

Long guns (Rifles, Shotguns, and PCCs) must be cased/uncased or removed/replaced on a cart with the muzzle pointed in a safe direction, as described above, directly into and within 2 yards of a side berm or backstop. Long guns can also be cased/uncased or removed/replaced on a cart under the direct supervision of a range officer with muzzle pointing at the backstop. Failure to point the muzzle at a side berm or back stop during casing/uncasing or removing/replacing on a cart will result in a DQ (*rule 5.2.4.1*)

Pre-load areas: Pre-loading **SHALL** only be allowed under the supervision of an RO (*rule 8.3.1.4*). Only the tube shall be pre-loaded. Anyone arriving to the line with a pre-loaded shotgun with a round in the chamber will be DQ'd (*rule 8.3.1.4.1*).

Pre-loading activity begins with a “Make Ready” command. All pre-loading activity including transporting loaded guns to start position(s) is subject to the provisions of relevant safety regulations, including (but not limited to) [10.4.3] (shot while loading), [10.5.1] (handling firearms without RO supervision), [10.5.2] (unsafe muzzle direction), [10.5.3] (dropped gun), [10.5.8] (finger inside trigger guard during loading), etc.

Final Safety Check @ conclusion of COF: Point unloaded shotgun downrange, close action, **pull trigger**, re-open action, apply safety, close bolt on chamber flag (*rule 8.3.7.1*).

Cleared shotguns shall not be placed back in pre-load areas (*rule 8.3.1.3*)

All firearms in staging areas must have their actions locked open or have a chamber flag on a closed bolt or be cased (*rule 2.4.1*).

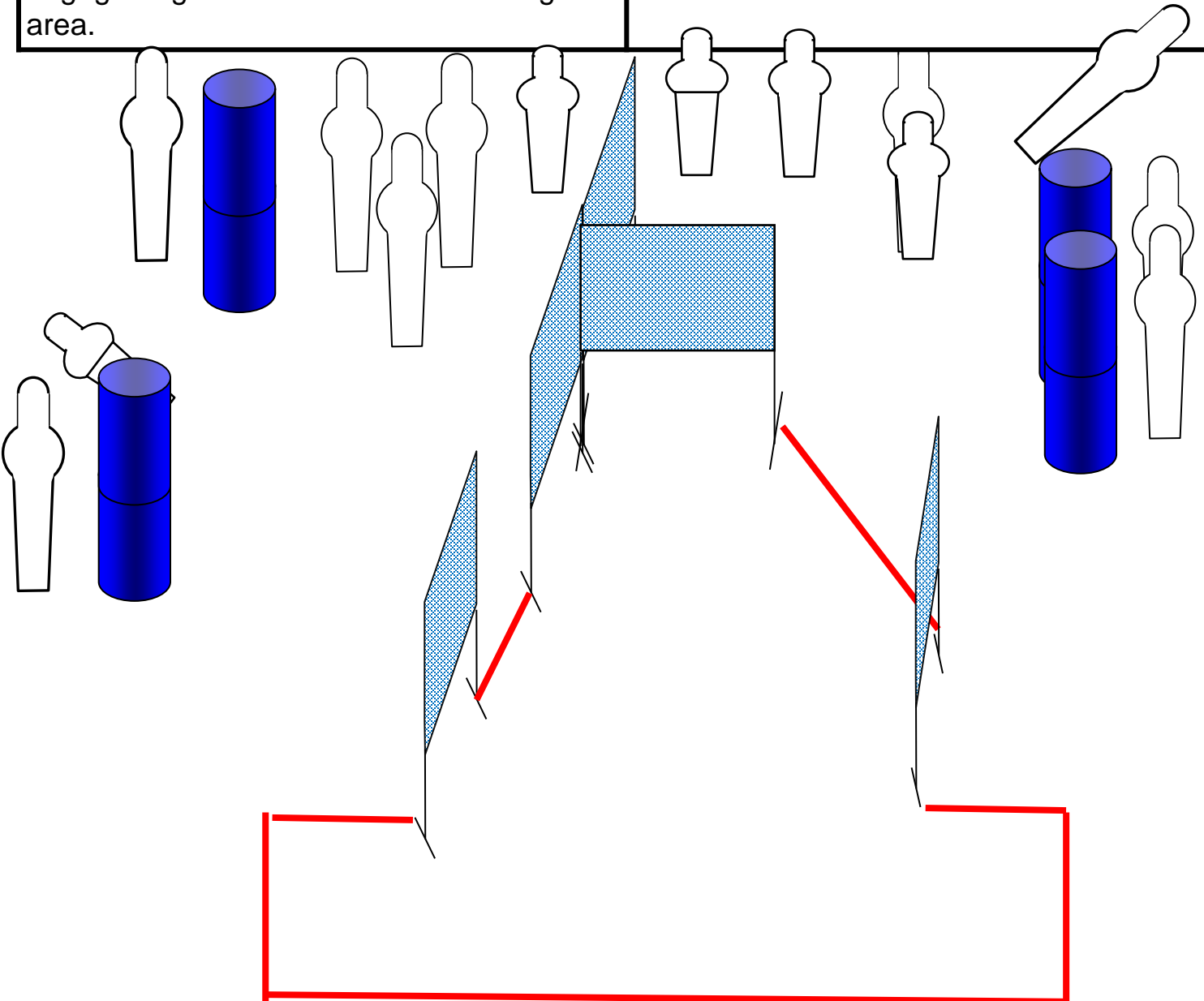

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Engage all targets from within the shooting area.

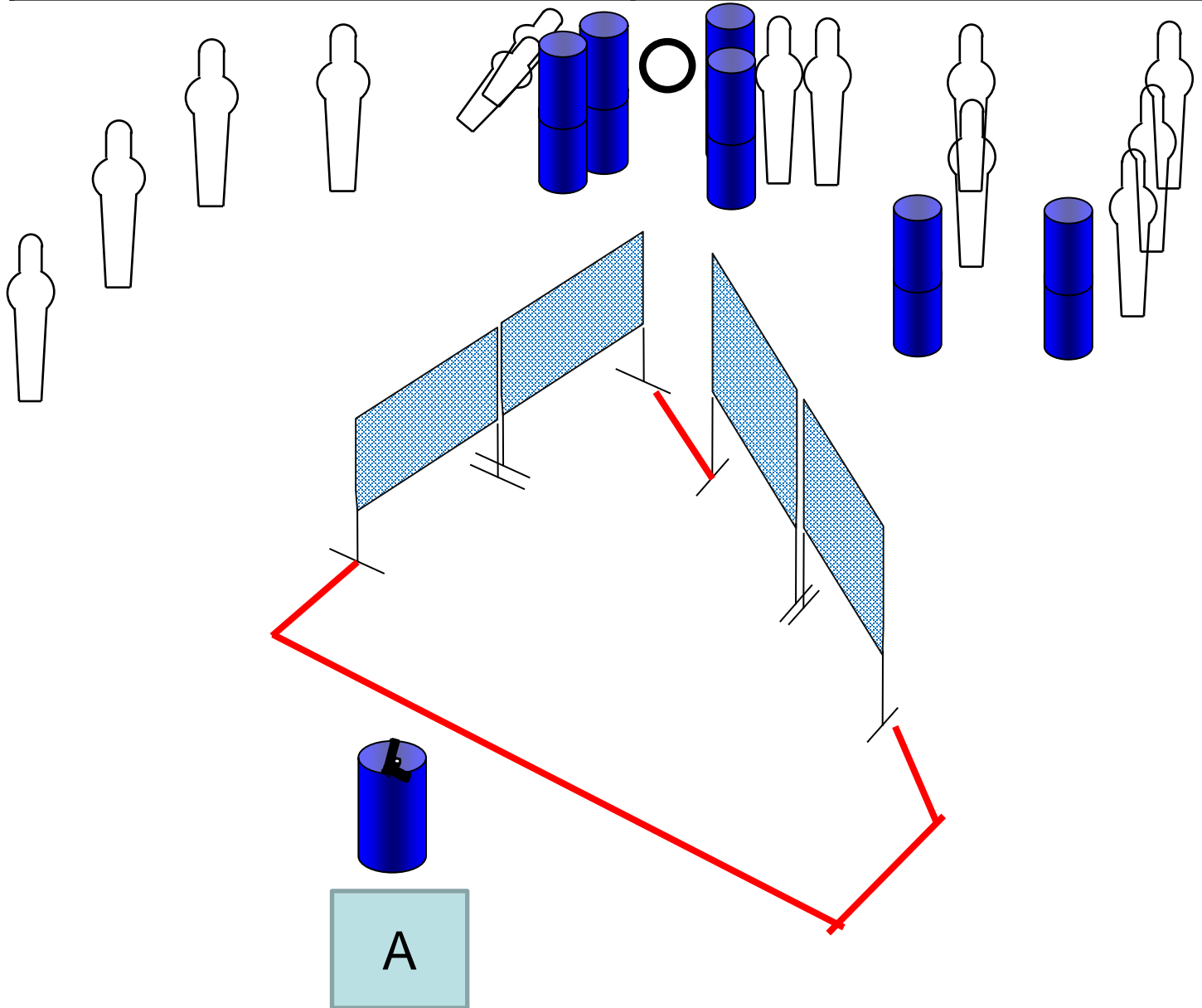
**SCORING:** Comstock, 14 rounds, 70 points

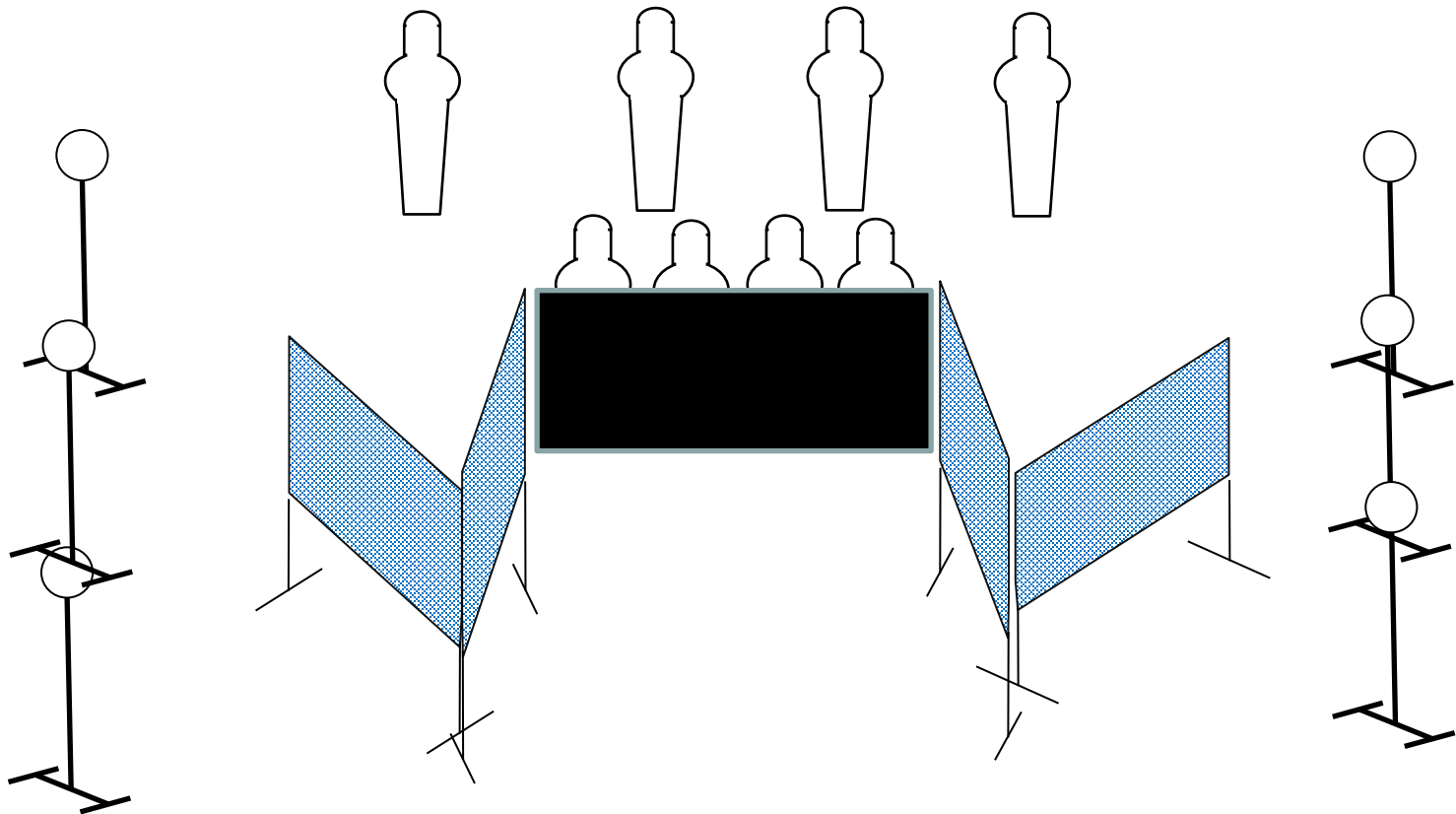

**SCORING:** Comstock, 15 rounds, 75 points

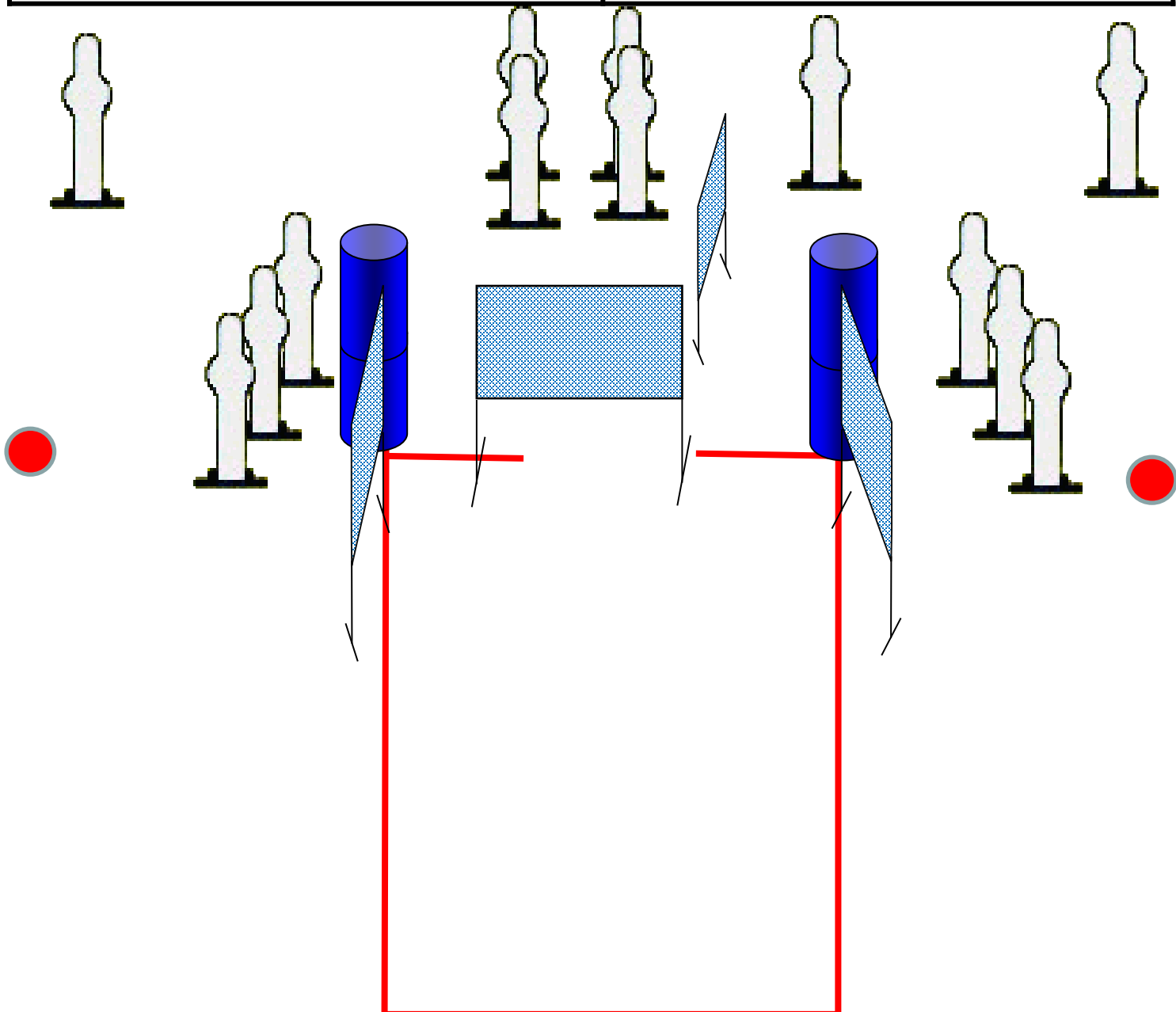
**TARGETS:** 13 Steel, 2 Clay Birds,

**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot

**SCORING:** Comstock, 14 rounds, 70 points

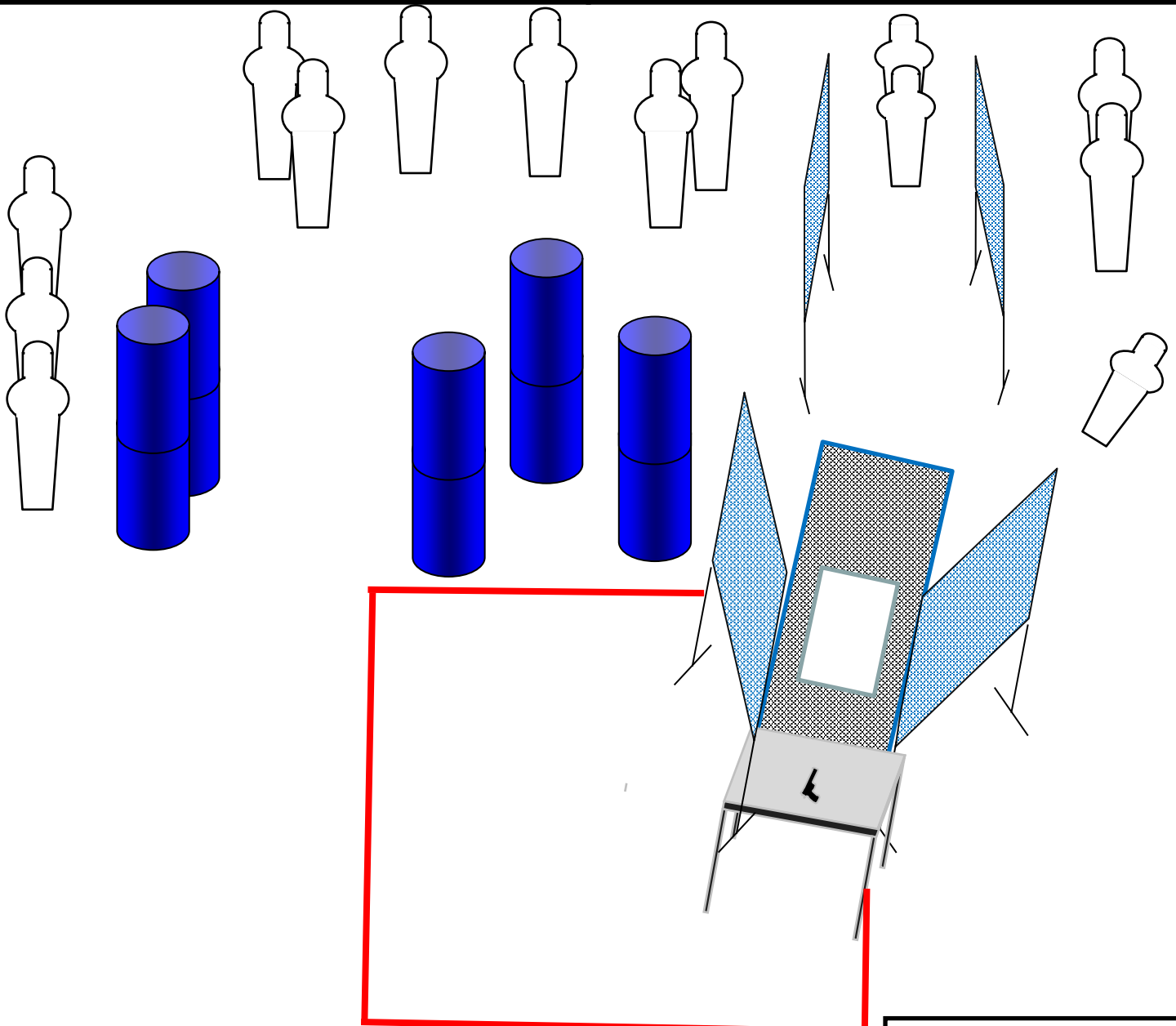

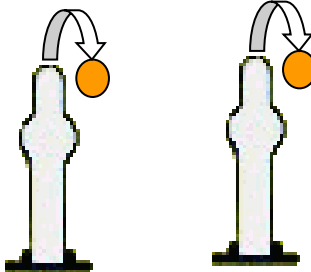
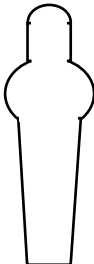
**GUN READY CONDITION:** Loaded shotgun on barrel.

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Engage all targets from Box A. USP1 activates Clay Bird #1. USP2 activates Clay Bird #2

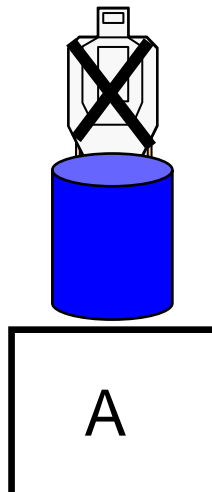
**SCORING:** Comstock, 6 rds., 30 pts.

# LIPSA 2022 Shotgun Match Accelerator - Shotgun Style !!

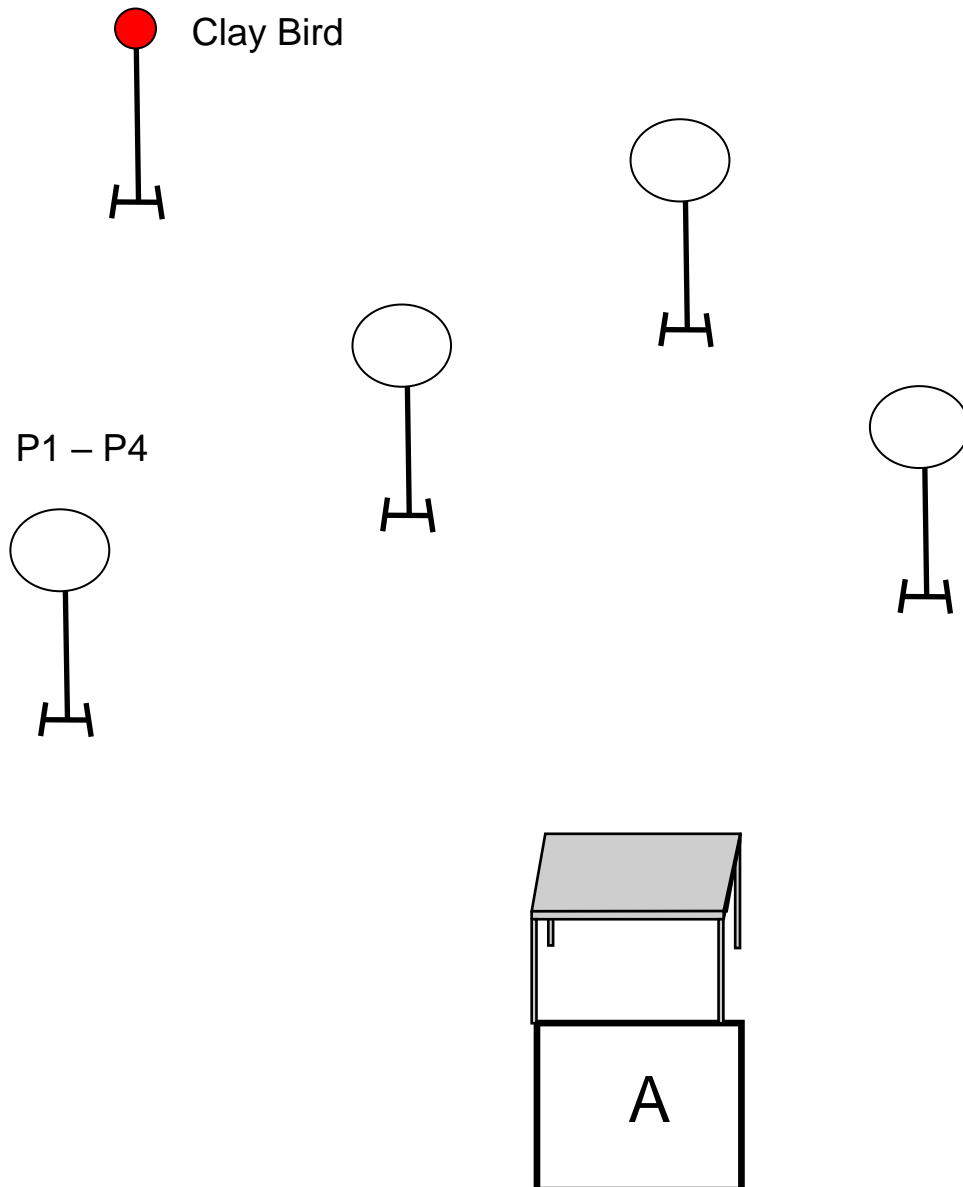
Stage Designer: R. Esposito

**START POSITION:** Standing in Box A, facing downrange, hands naturally at sides

**GUN READY CONDITION:** Loaded  
shotgun on table.

**SCORING:** Comstock, 5 rds., 25 pts.  
**TARGETS:** 4 steel. 1 clay bird  
**SCORED HITS:** KD = 1A, broken bird = 1A  
**START-STOP:** Audible - Last shot  
**RULES:** USPSA current edition

**STAGE PROCEDURE:** Upon start signal,  
engage P1 – P4 and clay bird from Box A.
